What's New for 2020

Nothing has changed when it comes to the awesome customer service and big mountain ski terrain at Mt Hutt, just two of many reasons why it's been voted New Zealand's best ski resort five years in a row. In 2020 Mt Hutt will continue working towards becoming a carbon neutral ski area through native planting, waste reduction initiatives and upgrading infrastructure.

- Doubling the supply rate of water for snowmaking with an additional bore – allowing our snowmakers to operate guns at full flow for much longer periods of time.
- More fully-automated fan guns and state-of-the-art land-guns to ensure the best quality snow is made exactly where we want it with the lowest possible impact on our environment.
- Boosting our grooming fleet with a cleaner, more efficient park groomer fitted with real-time snow depth measurement technology that will help us establish parks earlier in the season and further reduce emissions from our grooming operations.
- Brand new ski and board tuning equipment will enable a radically improved service from our on-mountain tech-shop and facilitate more regular tuning of our own standard and performance rental stock which also benefits from another big refresh this year.
- An additional 44-seater 4x4 shuttle bus is joining our fleet to load and transfer guests to/from our lower car-parks more efficiently and more comfortably.
- Improved safety on our access road with additional barriers and further improvements to car park and road surface quality.
- Offering guests the opportunity to join our campaign to regenerate Mt Hutt forests and offset the carbon from their travels by purchasing a native tree (or trees).

About Mt Hutt

Officially New Zealand's Best Ski Resort for the fifth year in a row*, Mt Hutt is New Zealand's big friendly mountain with some of the highest snow fall in the country delivering a long, white season.

At an altitude of 2086m with a 683 vertical drop Mt Hutt boasts the South Island's highest chairlift, leg-burning runs and some of the country's most spectacular views. As well as genuine Kiwi hospitality guests can enjoy wide groomed slopes, all-lift access for all abilities, top to bottom terrain parks and some of the best off-piste skiing around.

Mt Hutt in Canterbury has 365 ha of skiable terrain and state of the art snowmaking to top up the slopes. As a member of The Methven Kids4Free Deal, children 10 and under get a lift pass free of charge during the season.

- Home of the South Island's highest chairlift and the largest area of lift accessible terrain

- Ongoing facility, road and trail development in recent years has added new trails, enabled full implementation of SnowSAT technology in our grooming fleet, and increased snowmaking capacity
- High snowfall and exceptional snow quality makes for one of the longest ski seasons in NZ
- A choice of four freestyle terrain parks
- Exclusive Kids 4 Free deal - every child 10 years and under gets free lift pass every day at Mt Hutt (with a paying adult), as part of the www.kids4free.co.nz programme that also provides free accommodation, transport and meals in Methven.
- Extensive range of high-quality rental skis, boards, boots, clothing and helmets with overnight storage; ski/board tuning workshop and retail shop - on the mountain - right where you need it!
- 35-minute drive from Methven village; 90-minutes from Christchurch International Airport
