## **Information for Supervising Adults**

Listed below are some tips and useful information to help you as you accompany the school with their trip to Mt Hutt.

- Students are the responsibility of the school and accompanying supervisors on the day of your visit. Mountain staff will not supervise children on the mountain.
- Please ensure no bags are left on the bus, as this limits the number of students walking in the car park and ensures easy access to belongings if required.
- Bags can be left in our free of charge cubby holes on the main deck.
- Bags are not to be left in seating areas of the cafeteria.
- The group leader will liaise with mountain staff and organise passes, rentals, and lessons. If you have any concerns, please see your group leader directly.
- Any concerns or queries regarding instructors must be discussed with group leader who will speak with our Snowsports team.
- In the event of accident or emergency of any kind please contact any teachers on the trip with you.
- Please do not directly contact off-site parents regarding above.
- If you cannot reach any supervising teachers, please go to Guest Services.
- If you would like to hire our Performance equipment, you are welcome to, however, please be aware that this is charged at full price.
- Please be aware that lift passes will not be issued until all students have collected their equipment and are in lessons.
- All adult supervisors are expected to help students with equipment collection.

As a safety precaution for all beginners, at the start of the lesson we will collect each student's lift pass. This means they will not be able to gain access to the chairlift until they are of suitable ability.

Passes will be kept in our Snowsports office by the main meeting area for lessons. Passes will be reissued to students provided a supervising adult accompanies students to collect passes and is able to supervise them on the upper lifts and slopes for their safety. Alternatively, all collected passes may be returned to the group leader at the end of the lesson. In this instance, if a student would like to access the chairlift after their lesson, this is at the discretion of the group leader. The students must be accompanied on the mountain by school staff or supervisors.
